



APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The American Chesapeake Club Charitable Trust is pleased to announce the creation of a scholarship fund for students who are active in Conformation, Performance and/or Companion Events with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever dog breed. The individual scholarships will be \$1,000.00, with TWO scholarships being awarded annually, dependent upon suitable applications being received. The ACCCT Scholarship Program will be administered by ACCCT. NOTE: Funds awarded will be remitted directly to the recipients' school.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. All applicants must be active in Conformation, Performance and/or Companion events with a Chesapeake Bay Retriever.
2. All applicants must be U.S. citizens or legal residents.
3. All recipients must be students in High School (Junior or Senior) or attending a higher education institute (college or vocational), and be 21 years of age, or under, at the time of application submission.

Criteria for Awarding Scholarships:

1. Applicant's degree of involvement in competition events (*Example: as a handler, club member, assistant in hosting event, community involvement in promoting performance events, etc.*)
2. Applicant's higher education goals - vocational, two or four-year college program, or advanced studies beyond a four-year degree for the current academic year.
3. Applicant's GPA.
4. Extracurricular activities - school, community related, youth organizations (4-H, FFA, Scouts, etc.)

Application Deadline: February 1st
(awarded by May 1st)

All applications must be received on or before the deadline.

No application will be considered if it is incomplete (*See below*).
